Cable Installer

Position description:

Position purpose

The purpose of the Cabling Installer position is to grow the profitability of the business by efficiently coordinating the installation of first fix cabling.

Position duties

At all times the duties of the Cabling Installer are those required to achieve the position purpose.

Specific duties include;

- Running of cable to ACA requirements including cat 6 structured cabling systems. •
- Working at heights on ladders and scaffolds. •
- Competent use of power tools. •
- Soldering and Terminating of connectors (If suitably competent). •
- Accessing of confined spaces as in ceiling or under floors. •
- Able to follow and correctly interoperate schematic diagrams and building plans. •
- Working with other trades on a construction site. .
- Installation of Speakers, Video Projectors, Projection Screens, Equipment Racks, MATV and CCTV • and other audiovisual equipment.

The duties of the Cabling Installer include those listed above and any other tasks that may reasonably be expected from a person in a similar position.
